

A word-search puzzle from the Bible Pages. Theme: Kings of Israel and Judah.

47 words are hidden in this puzzle. They are printed across, or up or down, or diagonally, backwards or forwards, but always in a straight line, with no letters skipped. Each letter may form a part of more than one word. All letters do not belong to words, and there is no “hidden message”.

A note: Some kings appear more than once on this list, with different names and spellings. Also, some of the kings of Judah had the same name as some king of Israel, and vice versa; those names appear only once. Further, it can be debated whether certain of these men really were proper kings, since they had been appointed by foreign powers.

But, this is a word puzzle and not a history course.

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
