

A word-search puzzle from the Bible Pages. Theme: New Testament places and persons somehow connected with Greece.

58 words are hidden in this puzzle. They are printed across, or up or down, or diagonally, backwards or forwards, but always in a straight line, with no letters skipped. Each letter may form a part of more than one word. All letters do not belong to words, and there is no "hidden message".
